

Playford Alive Initiatives Fund

Frequently Asked Questions

The Playford Alive Initiatives Fund has been designed to encourage as many local groups / organisation's as possible to apply for funding to ensure that the Fund makes maximum contribution to the local community. Below is a sample of questions you may ask:

Q. Who can apply?

Local groups, schools and non-government organisations may apply if they meet one of the following conditions:

- They are legally constituted as an incorporated association or non-government organisation or;
- If not legally constituted, they have an incorporated organisation acting as the legal and financial sponsor for any grant funds received.

Q. Does your group need to be located within the Playford Alive project area?

No.

Applicants may be based outside the Playford Alive project area. However, the project and its participants must be located within the Playford Alive boundary and must benefit the Playford Alive community.

Q. Is there a limit to how much funding can be requested?

Yes.

The PAIF Board allocates \$60,000 per year for projects.

During the annual grant round, the expected maximum grant is \$10,000, though higher amounts may be considered on merit.

For small grants outside the annual round, the maximum request is \$2,500.

Q. Does the Fund require a contribution from applicants?

Yes.

Applicants must provide a matching contribution equal to the amount requested. This contribution may be:

- Cash, or
- In-kind support, such as volunteer labour or funds already raised for the project.

Q. Who assesses the applications?

All applications are assessed and determined by the Playford Alive Initiatives Fund Board, which allocates funding to successful applicants.
